

An oversupply of milk is causing depressed milk prices on the farm.

Ideas for a solution to this problem:

1. Implement a voluntary program.
2. Make the market place pay.
3. Put a surcharge on ALL dairy products at retail of 5-10% or more to go directly to farmers. Be honest and transparent with consumers as to why this is being done.
4. Put a floor on farm price of \$20/cwt or more for milk.
5. To receive the floor price a farmer must stay within 5% of his FSA base or pay \$10/cwt for over-production.
6. A farmer should be allowed to easily access or exit the program in his best interest.
